(The Dead Sea Scrolls)

The Dead Sea Scrolls, dating from 250 B.C. to A.D. 68, are one of the greatest archaeological finds of the 20th century. Found in the Judean desert by a Bedouin shepherd in 1947 along the shores of the Dead Sea in Israel, these ancient manuscripts embody universal values and bring to life an ancient world.

Come and join us in the St. Michael's room every Wednesday afternoon beginning August 2, 2017. This is a DVD based study presented by Dr. Gary A. Rendsbury, professor of Jewish studies at Rutgers University. Each week we will listen to Dr. Rendsbury discuss different aspects of the more than 800 documents found in this area of Israel. Included in his discussion is information about ancient Judaism, the origin of Christianity, and life in Roman Judea.
